Wernicke-Korsakoff syndrome that were unrelated to alcohol, somatic conditions that cause thiamine deficiency, such as bariatric surgery, cancer, and hyperemesis gravidarum, account for the majority [5] Although Wernicke-Korsakoff syndrome resulting from malnutrition associated with a psychiatric disorder is much less common,
