Signal timing is adapted to the measured traffic in real time. Traffic is measured and/or predicted, calculations are made and timing is implemented. "Adaptive" systems do not pick the best stored plan to match the measured traffic - that is "Traffic Responsive" (TRPS)

## **COMPUTERIZED TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYSTEMS (CTSS) GUIDELINES**

The FHWA Traffic Signal Timing Manual (FHWA-HOP-08-024) recommends retiming and re-evaluating signal systems every three (3) to five (5) years to ensure efficient operations. Below is a general list of benefits (2012 National Traffic Signal Report Card) for signal systems retiming, but not limited to: Improve Traffic Performance or Reduce delay
